Dear Greenwood Lake Residents and Businesses:

The Greenwood Lake Fire Department is hosting the 103rd annual Orange County Volunteer Fireman's Association parade on Saturday September 22nd. GLFD is celebrating 95 years of service to the Village of Greenwood Lake. The parade usually draws a large crowd of spectators. We expect approximately 40 fire departments and bands from the area to march in the parade.

The parade lineup will be on Teneyck Avenue starting at 1pm. The parade begins at 2pm and will last approximately three hours. The parade route is as follows: from Teneyck Ave. to Sterling Rd. Turn right on Waterstone Rd. Turn right on Linden Ave. Make a left on Willow Lane. Make a left on Windermere Ave. The parade will continue down Windermere Ave. and end at the Thomas P. Morahan Waterfront Park where there will be music, light refreshments, and an awards presentation.

We welcome all residents and businesses to participate in the day's events. We encourage you to decorate your storefronts and houses and host family and friends to watch the parade along the parade route. Spectators and firefighters will be in the village throughout the day and will likely visit many of the local businesses in Greenwood Lake.

There will be absolutely no street parking allowed starting Friday evening on September 21st on the roads mentioned above as well as the roads in Windermere Park and in the area of the town beach.

There will be numerous road closures throughout the day starting at approximately 12pm so please plan accordingly if you need to travel out of the village between 12pm and 5pm. Teneyck Ave. and Waterstone Road will close from approximately 1:45pm-3:30pm. Windermere Ave. will close from approximately 2:30pm-5pm. Once the parade is completed, all roads will open back up for normal traffic.
