VILLAGE OF GREENWOOD LAKE CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT FOR PARENTS AND PLAYERS

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents and Players Code of Conduct:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will not harass, taunt, intimidate, or verbally abuse any officials, coaches and players.
- I will not coach my child or interfere in any way with the coach and their decisions.
- I will always encourage my child, including times when they make mistakes and I will never criticize my child in front of anyone.
- I will not send any emails, voicemails, text messages or have verbal communication with my coach or to any other parent, harassing and/or showing disrespect of coaches or umpires or referees. All complaints will be dealt with respectfully and privately.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, serving as team parent or providing transportation.
- I will not cheer when the opposing team's player makes a mistake. I will not distract, criticize or intimidate the other players in any way.
- I will ensure that my child and my child's other parent and family members will abide by the condition of this agreement.
