BOND RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWOOD LAKE, ORANGE COUNTY, NEW YORK, ADOPTED APRIL 17, 2024, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$710,000, APPROPRIATING \$100,000 IN ADDITION TO THE \$610,000 HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED FOR SUCH PURPOSE; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE VILLAGE IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000, IN ADDITION TO THE \$200,000 BONDS HERETOFORE AUTHORIZED FOR THE PROJECT, TO FINANCE SAID ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION

The object or purpose for which bonds are authorized is the construction of sidewalk improvements. The estimated maximum cost of the project is \$710,000. The Village expects to receive \$410,000 from the United States of America, State of New York and/or other sources to pay a part of the cost of the project.

The amount of obligations to be issued is not to exceed \$100,000, in addition to the \$200,000 heretofore authorized for the Project.

The period of probable usefulness is limited five (5) years.

A complete copy of the Bond Resolution summarized above shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the office of the Village Clerk, Village Hall, 18 Church Street, Greenwood Lake, New York.
